- 1. Alcohol Beverage License Application – Don Lolos Mexican Restaurant:** Motion was made by Commissioner Thomas and seconded by Commissioner Robbins to approve the Alcohol Beverage Application for a Malt Beverage/Liquor License for Don Lolos Mexican Restaurant located at 3590 South Dixie Hwy, Dalton, GA. The motion was approved 3-0, with Chairman Jensen, and Commissioners Thomas and Robbins in agreement.
- 2. Dedication of Brooker Room in Edwards Park Community Center:** Chairman Jensen presented former District 2 Commissioner Harold Brooker a plaque in his honor naming the conference room at Edwards Park the Harold Brooker room. Brooker served on the Board of Commissioners for 24 years and advocated for the expansion of Whitfield County's recreation facilities while serving on the Board.
- 3. Sewer Expansion for Real Estate Development:** Motion was made by Commissioner Thomas and seconded by Commissioner Robbins to approve allocating \$900,000 in American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds for sewer expansion for a proposed housing development in Cohutta. The sewer expansion is contingent upon the developer, Three Point Development, LLC, out of Chattanooga, Tennessee closing on the 400 acre property located on Strain Road off of Cleveland Highway. The motion was approved 3-0, with Chairman Jensen, and Commissioners Thomas and Robbins in agreement.
