GUIDELINES FOR SIGN PLACEMENT

Whitfield County, GA - Whitfield County Board of Commissioners and the City of Dalton have released guidelines for the placement and removal of signs within the limits of unincorporated Whitfield County and the City of Dalton. Signage includes anything related to: political campaigns, advertising, etc.

Signs are Allowed in the Following Locations:

- Private property (with permission of property owner);
- Front and side yards of homes and businesses; and
- Storefront Windows.

Restrictions on Signs:

- In unincorporated Whitfield County residential areas, signs must not exceed 6 square feet in size;
- In City of Dalton residential areas, signs must not exceed 15 square feet in size;
- Signs are prohibited from being placed within any public right-of-way;
- Signs may not be placed within 10 feet of the side and rear lot lines; and
- Signs may not be placed within the City of Dalton's Gateway Corridor Overlay District (for the overlay district boundary please contact City Hall).

Removal of Signs

If any sign is in violation of these restrictions, please take immediate action to correct the placement. Failure to comply with the governing authority's sign ordinance will result in the removal of the sign.

Removed signs will be securely stored and can be collected by reaching out to the governing authority. Staff is available Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
