DONOR GIFTS TREE TO WHITFIELD COUNTY COURTHOUSE

Whitfield County, GA – On Monday, April 1st, the Whitfield County Board of Commissioner’s received the donation of a 21-foot Norway spruce in hopes to bring an old tradition back to the Whitfield County Courthouse.

For decades, a series of trees on the south lawn of the courthouse were decorated during the holiday season as a delight for visitors in the downtown area. The tree was donated in the honor of Sue Webb. Ms. Webb dedicated her life to supporting multiple programs throughout the year, and this donation will reignite the beloved tradition in her hometown.

“In the past few years, several residents have asked me about having a Christmas tree like the ones they remember from their childhoods,” said Jevin Jensen, Chairman of the Whitfield County Board of Commissioners. “Through the generosity of the donor, it allowed us to bring back the tradition, enhance it, and watch the new tree grow.”

The tree was installed at the corner of Crawford and Selvidge Street where it will be easily visible to motorists and pedestrians. Members of the Whitfield County Buildings and Grounds, and Public Works Department, worked diligently with Largetree Transplant Specialists to ensure its new placement will be in a thriving environment.

“We are grateful to be a part in bringing a tradition back with private-public partnerships without imposing additional costs on taxpayers,” Chairman Jensen added.
